5) Class Rule changes. (see Appendix A)

- a) Proposal to change from 3 fins to 2 fins **APPROVED – 10 YES; 7 NO**
- b) Proposal to change from 3 sails to 2 sails **APPROVED – 9 YES; 8 NO**
- c) The meeting considered that solid colours was a good thing for marketing, but should be a decision of the industry. **NOT APPROVED – 3 YES; 10 NO**

6) Marketing.

It was agreed that the Formula Class develop a comprehensive plan to ensure continued growth and development for the benefit of both the sailors as well as the manufacturers. The most important vehicle to growth is promotion. Currently, general marketing and promotion of the class is lacking due to

limited resources

APPROVED – 16 YES; 1 NO

It was agreed to establish a Marketing Working Party to report to the Committee with recommendations.

7) Open “development” Class (or division)

It was agreed that the “Free Formula” concept be developed, but not as a new class. Open Development Class was .. **NOT APPROVED- 3 YES; 11 NO**

8) Future Events.

No confirmed dates could be announced for the 2012 Championship calendar; although many options were under review.
